

NONAs: New to the Construction General Permit

NONAs have been in existence for some time under the Industrial General Permit, but with the renewal of the Construction General Permit last year, NONAs were adopted for construction sites across the State. So, what does that mean for construction storm water programs? Can I qualify for a NONA on my site? In this month's edition of **The Monthly Dirt**, we are going to dive into the world of NONAs and help you find out if your project site qualifies for this permit exemption!

What is a NONA: NONA stands for Notice of Non-Applicability. In other words, a NONA is notifying the Water Board that your site is not applicable to the Construction General Permit due to the fact that there is no discharge from your site. The 2022 Permit describes it as the following: "A discharger claiming "No Discharge" through a Notice of Non-applicability (NONA) as set forth in Water Code § 13399.30 shall meet the following eligibility requirement:

a. The site's physical location is not hydrologically connected to waters of the United States.

When claiming the "No Discharge" option, the discharger shall submit and certify via SMARTS both the NONA and a No Discharge Technical Report. The No Discharge Technical Report shall identify the site by address or parcel number and demonstrate that the site meets the eligibility requirement described above in Section III.E.1.a. The No Discharge Technical Report shall be signed (wet signature and license number) by a California licensed professional engineer or geologist with hydrological expertise. The Regional Water Board may require the No Discharge Technical Report to be reassessed if it determines that there are errors in the No Discharge Technical Report or if the site is

hydrologically connected to waters of the United States."

The Fact Sheet of the 2022 CGP also states, "Reliance on approved jurisdictional determinations is not allowed in the General Permit for a number of reasons. First, approved jurisdictional determinations delineate the scope of waters of the United States. They do not determine whether an activity results in a discharge to a water of the United States. Second, the scope of waters of the United States is subject to changes based on change of regulations or judicial decisions. Approved jurisdictional determinations are valid for a discrete number of years, and they may not be up-to-date with respect to implementing the current regulations if there is an intervening change during the duration of the validity the approved jurisdictional of determination. Finally, it is likely that the approved jurisdictional determination was requested by another party and in another context, such as the discharge of dredged or fill material. As such, the findings may not be easily extrapolated."

What the process used to be: Under the 2009 Permit the Water Board recognized there were certain scenarios

where construction projects may not have any discharge and were not connected to the Waters of the United States. But under the 2009 Permit, NONAs didn't exist. Or at least, they didn't exist formally. It was dealt with in a little different way - more of an informal way. The 2009 Permit contained a clause about possibly being exempt from Permit coverage if there were "discharges occurring in basins that are not tributary or hydrologically connected to waters of the United States." However, it went on to state that, for more information, the discharger was to contact their Regional Water Board. There was also an Notice of Termination option provided under the 2009 CGP for this same scenario. Essentially under the old permit projects were allowed to be exempted from permit coverage if there was "no way and no how" that water would flow from the project to the Waters of the United States. However, the determination and documentation criteria for these instances was subject to the local Regional Water Board reviewer.

How to obtain a NONA now:

Under the 2022 Permit the non-applicability criteria became standardized and no longer subject to reviewer discretion and interpretation. If you're familiar with the Industrial General Permit, a construction NONA is quite similar, not identical, but

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similar to the IGP process. The difference between the IGP and the CGP is that for those under the CGP, there's only one requirement for your site in order to qualify for a NONA. **The site's physical location cannot be connected to the Waters of the United States.** (For those interested, under the IGP, the NONA criteria is a bit more stringent and there are two requirements for NONAs – the facility has impoundment capacity for the largest historical storm, or the facility is not hydrologically connected to the Waters of the United States.)

In order to file for a no discharge NONA, you will need to fill out a form on SMARTS, and also submit a **no discharge technical report**. This report must be signed by a California licensed professional engineer or geologist who has hydrological experience. This is the other big change in how non-applicability is being determined, in the new CGP, the Water Board is leaving it up to the professionals to prove that that site is eligible for a NONA and is not hydrologically connected to the Waters of the United States. Now it is not exclusively at the discretion of the Regional Board reviewer. (Of course, the Regional Board still reviews the submitted technical plan for completeness and to check for errors. But as long as the plan is well prepared and stamped by a California licensed professional engineer or geologist with hydrological expertise, the submitted plan will be accepted.) The

technical report needs to demonstrate that the project site does not discharge to an MS4 or to a water body of the United This could include ephemeral States. streams as well. The technical report would also need to demonstrate that storm water from the site does not infiltrate into the subsurface via porous aggregate and become shallow groundwater which is rapidly transmitted laterally to a nearby body of water. Groundwater is not considered Waters of the United States, rather it is considered to be waters of the State. But that doesn't mean the groundwater is not hydrologically connected. We had a site in Maui which was having discussions with the USEPA about whether they were connected to the ocean by water which discharged into the very sandy porous soil. The USEPA said that, just by the proven speed the water met the ocean, they believed it to be hydrologically connected. This can get quite complex and is probably why the Water Board is leaving it up to the professionals to determine if a site is hydraulically disconnected from water of the United States and to create a no discharge technical report. It's a new formalized process even though it existed before in an informal way but it should produce more defendable notices of non-applicability.

Attached to this newsletter is the Water Board's guidance document on submitting a

NONA for the CGP.

How many NONAs are there

currently? At the time of the writing of this article, since the reissuance of the 2022 CGP last year, the Water Board has already issued nine NONAs to construction sites across the State. But where are they? Is your site near one and maybe also qualifies for a NONA? The above map shows where these nine NONAs are located to assist you in seeing if you are close to where a NONA has already been filed. The nine NONAs appear to be primarily located in the interior of California in arid or semi-arid areas and are comprised of a mix of residential, commercial, and utility projects. Notice of Non-Applicability (NONA)

Statewide Construction Stormwater General Permit (CGP) – Notice of Non-Applicability (NONA)

Construction sites that are not hydrologically connected to waters of the United States may opt to file for a NONA instead of a Notice of Intent. A construction site is not hydrologically connected when the site does not discharge precipitation directly into a water of the United States.

Construction sites that are not hydrologically connected filing a NONA select the "No Discharge" option and are required to upload a No Discharge Technical Report. The No Discharge Technical Report demonstrates the construction site does not discharge to a Waters of the United States and shall be signed (wet signature and license number) by a California licensed professional engineer or geologist with hydrological expertise.

The Notice of Non-Applicability must be certified and submitted by either the Legally Responsible Person (LRP) or Duly Authorized Representative (DAR). This guide provides general guidance for the LRP or DAR to complete a Notice of Non-Applicability certification. After the completion check errors are identified, go back to the "Certification" tab and "Perform Completion Check" again. If no errors display, continue to certify the NONA.

Any user may perform this check, but if a DEP performs the check, the system provides a "Notify LRP/DAR" button. Pressing the button notifies the LRP or DAR the NONA is complete and requires their certification. The LRP or DAR should review the prepared NONA for accuracy prior certifying.

The LRP or DAR must have the signed electronic authorization form on file before the application can be certified. If the form is not on file, select "Print E-Authorization Form," sign with original wet signature preferably in blue ink, then mail it to the Water Boards.

LRP or DAR Certification

There are two options for the LRP or DAR to submit the NONA:

- a. The LRP or DAR may access the "Documents Ready for Certification" SMARTS menu option if notified by the DEP.
 - Select the NONA to certify by checking the box next to the Application ID.
 - Check the box next to the certification statement, answer the security questions, and enter the user account password.
 - Click "Certify Selected" to submit the NONA.
